





Skills You'll Master When You Earn Your IT Fundamentals+ Certification




#2 INFRASTRUCTURE

different types of applications and how they can help you perform your job better? With ITF+ you will learn about the purpose and use of several software applications and understand the basics of installing and configuring them.




#4 SOFTWARE DEVELOPMENT Applications are created by programmers.
